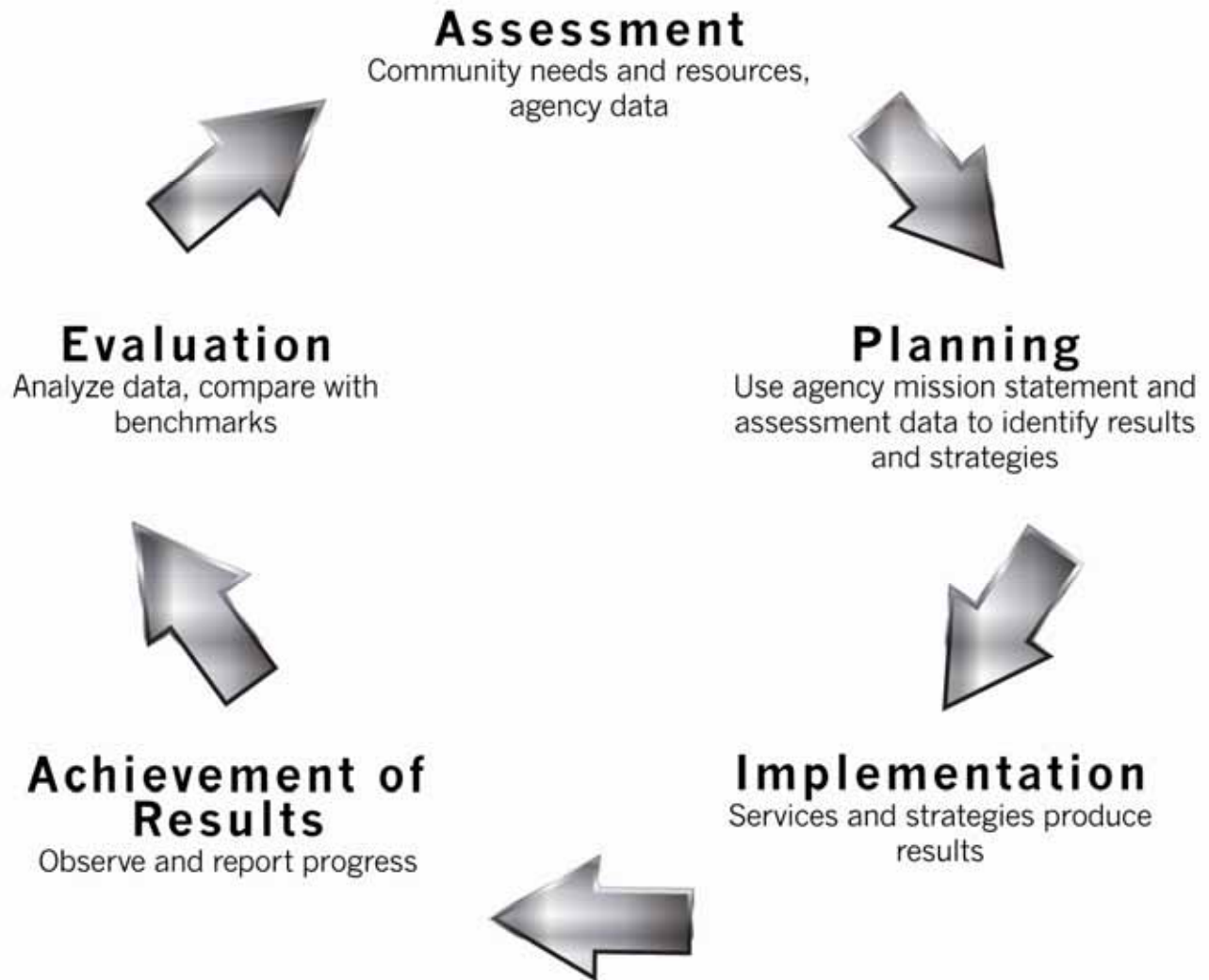


# The Results Oriented Management and Accountability Cycle
