

## FORM OF NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS SINGLE FAMILY MORTGAGE REVENUE AND REFUNDING BONDS

Notice is hereby given of a telephonic public hearing to be held by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs (the "Department") on June 16, 2021, at 12:00 pm. Interested parties may join the public hearing on the date and the time indicated above by dialing (877) 336-4440 (US Toll Free) and, when prompted, entering the access code 9287768#.

The public hearing is regarding a plan of financing that includes the proposed issuance of several series of "qualified mortgage bonds" (collectively, the "Bonds") under Section 143 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,250,000,000. The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to (i) make single family residential mortgage loans to eligible very low, low and moderate income homebuyers for the purchase of homes located within the State of Texas or (ii) refund all or a portion of the Department's outstanding single family mortgage revenue bonds, the proceeds of which were used directly or indirectly to provide single family residential mortgage loans. All interested parties are invited to telephonically attend the public hearing to express their views with respect to the Department's mortgage loan finance program and the plan of finance for the issuance of the Bonds.
